

BRANHAM Estate Wines

Planted in 1994 the Branham Rockpile represents the first vineyard of BEW. At that time, we had no idea just how unique the terroir of this location would be (Rockpile AVA). The vines at this vineyard produce distinctive zinfandel fruit that belies its relative youth. The vines are head trained and non-irrigated. Deep ruby color with brilliant purple tones. Ample dark berry aromas with light smoky notes. The familiar signature blackberry flavor of this Rockpile Zin resonates at the finish.
